Construction of main return air shaft of Kinsenda Copper Company was successfully completed

On June 5, 2018, the construction of new main return air shaft of Kinsenda Copper Company under Metorex Holdings Limited, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Jinchuan Group International Resources co., LTD., was successfully completed.

The new return air shaft is designed and constructed under the condition that the original return air shaft cannot meet the ventilation capacity of mine during production, the well depth is 220 meters and net diameter of the wellbore is 4.5 meters. South Africa Master Drilling Company was responsible for construction by using raise-boring machine and Kinsenda Copper Company was responsible for project management. During wellbore excavation, the average daily drilling depth was 10.8 meters, and the maximum daily drilling depth reached 17.6 meters.

After the new return air shaft is put into use, the new return air system of Kinsenda Copper Company will replace the old one gradually to ensure the safe production of mine.
